### 18/756 - ITEM 3a - KTC Public Speaking Session

A resident spoke to council regarding **Item 7.2 Salt bins**, she explained that she has lived on Manor Drive for 20+ years and up until a couple of years ago there was a salt bin (outside the Brethren meeting hall). The resident has contacted NYCC to be told the area does not meet the Council's criteria for a bin; however the cul-de-sac that she lives in is particularly steep. She has collected a petition of 49 signatures from people in the area that would like to see a salt bin reinstated.

Councillor Z Metcalfe spoke to inform members that she had met with the resident and had subsequently contacted NYCC Area 6 and was awaiting a response that she would feed back to KTC.

No pedestrian crossing islands are shown except at the two roundabouts. Pedestrian crossing facilities need to be provided at various points throughout the development.  There is mention of 'pedestrian links'. All such links will get used by cyclists so all routes should be designed as shared use routes for pedestrians and cycles.  Shared cycle routes that are shown are not wide enough. At least three metre widths should be surfaced to allow easy use by walkers and cyclists moving in both directions.  Not all roads and junctions are wide enough for easy access by buses.  Bus routes should give good access from Eastfield to the rail halt and from the rail halt to the roundabout.  The tree-lined avenue aligned to give views of the church steeple is not wide enough between the trees. The trees need to be far enough apart to allow for tree growth without obscuring the view.  On a separate note, KTC would like to add that it was felt the quality of scans for this application is very poor. On such an important application some members felt it was difficult to access the important details.
