19/145 ITEM 3a - KTC Public Speaking Session

i) Two residents attended to speak against planning application 19/000358/FUL. They outlined their objections to the meeting (having previously submitted them in writing) and invited Councillors to view 2 Ethel Crescent from their property if they so wished.

The Mayor moved to take Item 6 - 19/00358/FUL - Retention of raised roof height, rooflights and altered fenestration to a two storey extension - 2 Ethel Crescent HG5 0DJ

RESOLVED: That KTC objects to this application as it is over intensive development of the site and the extension does not comply with Harrogate Borough Council's policies on extensions - i.e. it is not subservient to the main building.

ii) The Liability Negotiations Adviser from Network Rail had been invited to attend re Item 5.1 Frogmire footpath level crossing. He spoke to members and outlined why Network Rail is looking to close this crossing. He mentioned safety concerns, alternative solutions (a bridge) and plans to enhance an alternative footpath. He stated that an application to close the crossing had not yet been made, and that Knaresborough Town Council would be a statutory consultee when any such application is made.

The Mayor moved to take Item 5.1 - To consider email from Liability Negotiations Adviser, network Rail re Frogmire footpath level crossing.

Members raised several questions and concerns regarding the proposed closure.

RESOLVED: That Knaresborough Town Council objects to the closure of the footpath e - d (as detailed on Appendix 1 to these minutes) and asks that further investigation be done regarding the provision of a foot bridge with ramps. And that the investigation should look into a foot bridge far easier to use than the one presented at this meeting. This council feels that it must be possible to negotiate with the land owners to create a foot bridge in line with the present footpath.

iii) A Volunteer (Event Organiser) attended to speak in support of the Parkrun application for grant funding.
